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Power Station of Art presents 21 years of One Minutes

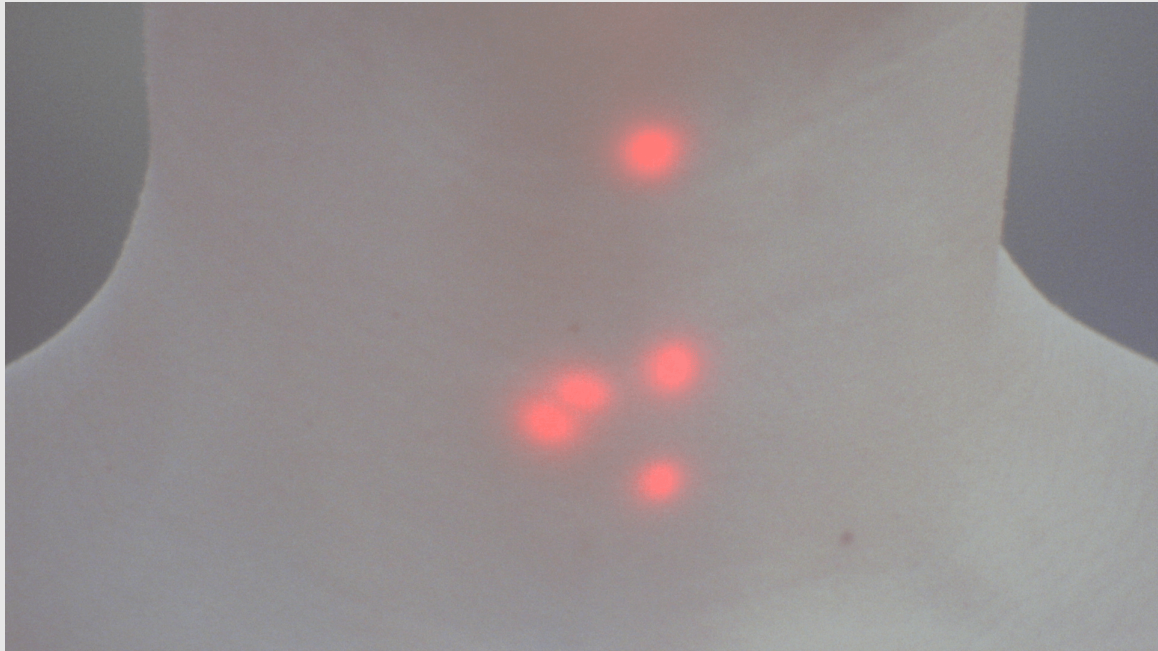

Power Station of Art (PSA) in Shanghai (CN) presents *刹那即永恒 - One Minute is Eternal - Celebrating 21 years of One Minutes* from 23 October until 24 November 2019.

A rich mix of design, music production, long-take cinema, poetic and experimental approaches – the collection of works pull from all disciplines. *刹那即永恒 - One Minute is Eternal* is an eclectic range of propositions in how we think through the medium of moving image.

Since 1999, The One Minutes Foundation has produced and distributed one minute videos from an artistic point of view, offering an international stage for people to create, engage and connect. The One Minutes Collection consists of over 10,000 video works by artists from more than 120 countries.

Power Station of Art is the first state-run museum dedicated to contemporary art in mainland China. Renovated from a former power plant, PSA was the Pavilion of Future during the 2010 Shanghai World Expo. As Shanghai's generator for its new urban culture, PSA regards non-stopping innovation and progress as the key to its long-term vitality. The museum has been striving to provide an open platform for the public to learn and appreciate contemporary art, break the barrier between life and art, and promote cooperation and knowledge generation between different schools of art and culture.
